

Tip for Quilters

Add a little liquid starch to water in a spray bottle to use when ironing a block before your final "squaring up" cut. The sizing will help keep the blocks shape and it will help it to lay flat. It also adds a nice crisp finish to your block.

Instead of drawing a diagonal line on your half-square triangle blocks, press a crease from corner to corner diagonally and use that as your guide for stitching. Be sure to use an up and down pressing motion vs a gliding motion when ironing.

Save all of the leftover strips of binding and sew them together to make a great scrappy finish for another quilt.

When hand appliquéing, try pinning your pieces through the back instead of the front of the block. This will prevent your thread from getting tangled in your pins. If you must use pins from the front, try sequin pins. They are short and minimize the possibility of thread tangle.

The new Designer Diamond is a jewel in the Husqvarna-Viking Designer series of machines that sets a whole new standard in sewing and embroidery. We will be offering a once-a-month class which will help you learn this machine from top to bottom. You will do a small project each month using all the unique features of this new machine. Double Wedding Ring

This is a old pattern with a new twist. It is cut out with a rotary cutter and sewn on a sewing machine. During the class I will demonstrate how the pieces are cut out, but because of time there will be a pre-cut kit. When completed you will have a wedding ring table runner.
